Summary of Complaint:

Due to violations of the Elections Code by the Elections Committee, Poll workers, and Attorney General, in the areas of Secret Ballot, Duties of the Chair, Polling Districts, Elections Officials, Notice of Elections, and Tabulation of results, the ASUNM Election was not conducted in a way inconsistent with the ASUNM Law Book. It is my contention that the Election should be ruled invalid and redone in a way consistent with the ASUNM Law Book.

Detailed List of Alleged Violations;

Secret Ballot; Not enough privacy was provided.

*Voters were intimidated by Poll workers watching them vote.*

Elections Code:

Article IV: Duties of the Chair

Section 1.H ~~To prepare and furnish printed instructions which clearly explain how voters may cast their ballots.~~

*Printed instructions were not provided.*

Article VI: Election Officials

Section 1. Poll Workers.

B. Poll workers must meet the same qualifications as Elections Commissioners.

*The Attorney General Non ASUNM members (DebiMorris) were used.*

D. The Elections Commission Chair will provide identification badges for all poll workers which will indicate that the wearer is a poll worker and will display the name of the poll worker. Identification badges must be worn at all times during the performance of duties.

*Identification badges were not worn.*

Article VIII: Notice of Elections

Section 4.

Notification for hiring Poll workers will be placed in the NM Daily Lobo for two (2) consecutive days not less than fourteen (14) days prior to the election and must include procedures for applying.

*These positions were not advertised.*

Article XVI: Tabulation of Results

Section 1.

No other than the Elections Commission, election officials, designated assistants, Official Poll Watchers, one (1) official representative each from the NM Daily Lobo and KUNM, and professionals required will be present during the tabulation of the election results.

*The Attorney General, not an election official tabulated results.*
